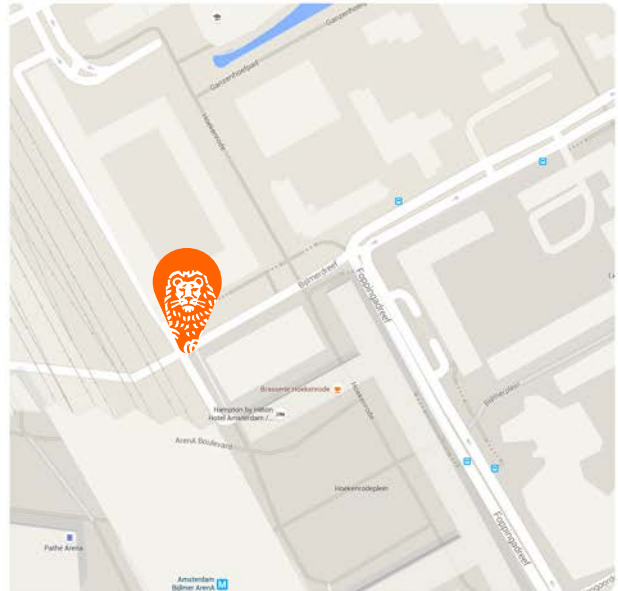
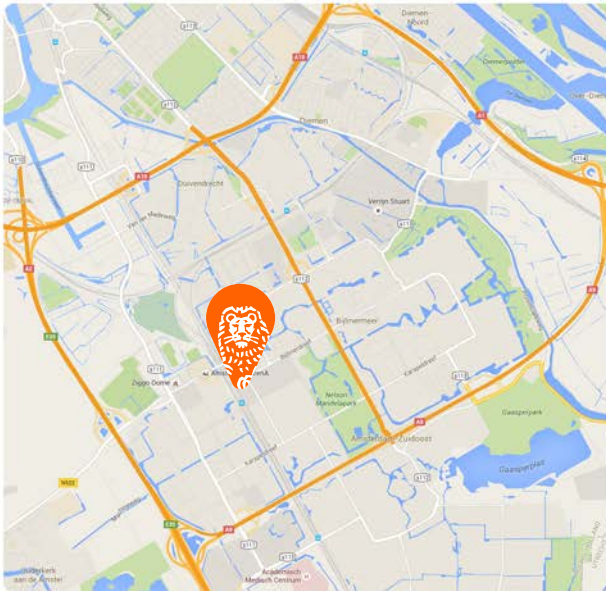

Route description



By car

GPS coordinates for navigation

Latitude: 52°18'48.6"N

Longitude: 4°56'48.9"E

from all directions

On the A2 motorway take the Ouderkerk aan de Amstel / Duivendrecht exit (exit no. 1). At the end of the sliproad, turn left onto the Burgemeester Stramanweg, N522, in the direction of Amsterdam-Zuidoost. Continue on the Burgemeester Stramanweg (underneath the Amsterdam ArenA). After a few hundred meters there is a T-crossing. Turn right and at the next traffic lights turn right again. You are now on the Bijlmerdreef. This road bends to the left. In the bend turn right. You see Acanthus right in front of you. Please take the visitors entrance of the parking garage.

Visitors without an ING badge please use entrance A. The other entrances (B and C) are unmanned and can only be used by visitors with an ING badge. In the parking garage the entrances are marked with letters and colors.



By public transport

Acanthus is located next to the Amsterdam Bijlmer Arena train station that can be reached:

- from Amsterdam, Utrecht and Rotterdam by slow train;
- from the Amsterdam Central, Duivendrecht railway stations by metro 54 towards Gein;
- from the Amsterdam Sloterdijk, Lelylaan railway stations by metro 50 towards Gein;
- from Schiphol airport by intercity trains or bus line 300.

From the Bijlmer Arena station you walk towards the Esprit Outlet Store and across the 'Kiss and Ride' parking lot. You see the Acanthus building in front of you. Near the building go up the stairs on the right. Around the corner is the A-part entrance. Visitors without an ING access badge please use this entrance. For the C-part entrance you walk along the ING logo and around the corner. The B-part entrance is on the other side of the building. At the end of the plateau walk down the stairs, turn left and after 100 meters turn left again and up the stairs. Both entrances are unmanned and you need an ING access badge to enter.

From the Amsterdam Bijlmer Arena station it is about a five minute walk to Acanthus.
